Dear Ridge Crest Families,

This activity encourages students and their families to read together at home. The support and feedback from the past few years has been so great that we have brought it back. I am excited to have an activity in which our entire school community can participate.

We are sending home a free book to every family regardless of whether or not you choose to participate. Every family receives the same book and reading assignments. This year’s book is *Frindle*.

A two-week calendar is attached with the reading assignment for each day. The goal is to have students and their families read the assigned pages or chapters each day. After reading please help your child answer the comprehension question for that reading assignment. Have your child write the answer down and bring it to school. The next day at school your child will answer the question in class to show that he or she read the assigned pages. If your child answers the question correctly, he or she will be entered into a classroom drawing for that day.

Please visit our website to listen to and see videos of guest readers reading the nightly assigned reading. Some of our readers are school staff and others are famous people from our community.
